The Lake Chad Basin Commission (LCBC) received funding from the International Development Association (IDA) to cover the cost of the Lake Chad Region Recovery and Development Project (PROLAC). The objective of the Project is to meet regional development challenges in the Lake Chad region and to contribute to the recovery of the region through the following five (5) components: (i) National and regional coordination platform and local capacity building ; (ii) Restoration of rural mobility and connectivity on and around Lake Chad ; (iii) Productive investments and value chains development ; (iv) Project's Management ; (v) Emergency Response Component.

The Project implementation period is five (5) years (2020 - 2025).

The LCBC is responsible for the implementation of Component 1 relating to the Regional Knowledge Platform and Regional Secretariat for the Lake Chad Development.

For the implementation of the project, a Project Implementation Unit (PIU) will be set up under the supervision of the Technical Department of LCBC.
